Mr. Hamilton spoke on the lack of a sidewalk on the south side of Heights Elementary School. He said this had been on the City books since 2010 and the last time the Commission addressed this at Mr. Lee's request, they agreed on delaying the sidewalk as Desert Star Elementary was being built. He mentioned at the time it would have cost \$29,000 to put the sidewalk in. He stated it had been six years and wanted something to be done about the sidewalk.

Hugene Downer commented on the following:

Mr. Downer spoke on the economy in the City and asked what we could do to keep service members in our community. He complimented Mayor Pro-Tem Hernandez on the green grass at his residence and asked him to work with Community Services Director Ortega to plant trees. Mayor Pro-Tem Hernandez thanked him and stated he had one of the few wells in the City.

Harrison Reeves commented on the following:

Mr. Reeves spoke on a tree that fell on the sidewalk of 2409 Saguaro Loop due to the wind storm that occurred a couple of weeks ago. He said the property was vacant and stated several people had contacted the City regarding the tree and the weeds at that property. He thought this was a fire and safety hazard and wanted to call attention to the Commission to at least have tree removed.

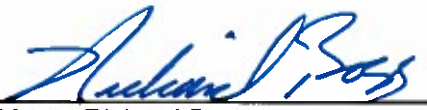
